



Key Changes

Following careful analysis of feedback received at the pre-application stage and completion of further surveys and assessments the following key changes have been made to the scheme:

- Stack height reduced to 75m (a reduction of 10m)
- Height of the main building reduced to 45m (a reduction of 2m)
- Reduced capacity of 250,000 tonnes of waste per annum (a reduction of 100,000 tonnes to ensure that the facility is well sized to provide the recovery capacity needed for residual waste arisings in Berkshire.)
